TEAMPAILLÍN FACHTNA

Although Teampaillín Fachtna has been an important site of pilgrimage since ancient times, very little is actually known about the site.

It is situated on the top of Burgatia Hill, about one mile east of Rosscarbery (as the crow flies). As The Causeway and present road network did not then exist, it was approached from Ross by stepping stones across The Lagoon and the present-day road up Burgatia Hill. This route later became the location of the main road from Cork.

It is believed that St Fachtna, who established his monastery and school in Ross, about 570, established churches at Kilfaughtnabeg (Glandore) and in Knocknageehy (Cnoc na Gaoithe) and regularly visited them.

Local tradition is that St Fachtna used to stop at the site of Teampaillín Fachtna, on his journey to and from Knocknageehy for meditation and to read his Breviary. On one occasion he left his Breviary behind him, it rained heavily that night, but when Fachtna returned the following morning, a small oratory had sprung up over the spot, protecting his Breviary.

It appears that a small structure, about 12 feet by 8, was built in much earlier times and may even be associated with the Knights Templars. This structure appears to have been rebuilt about 1664, a small flat stone on the north east corner of the building, has a partly obliterated inscription "Ad Gloriam Dei 16.."

The present structure had fallen into disrepair and was rebuilt about sixty years ago. The site has also been used as a burial ground.

The road approaching Teampaillín from the west is still known today as "Bohirínn a Marbh". St Fachtna's Holy Well is located just east of the site, on the right-hand side of the hill down from the Teampaillín. It has been a site of

pilgrimage ever since. Mass has traditionally been celebrated there on the feast of The Assumption, 15th August.

Please note that Mass this year is being celebrated on Thursday 14th August.
