ADMISSION TO HOLY COMMUNION

It has become our practice to admit children in second class of primary school to the sacrament of the Eucharist during the season of Easter. Admitting such young children is a relatively recent practice; you used to have to be confirmed first (like in the Eastern churches in Ukraine, Greece, Iraq, Lebanon, etc.) but among us at a slightly older age before being allowed to receive Holy Communion. All thirteen churches in our families of parishes are old enough to have witnessed the older practice: the bishop came to confirm the children, some time later, maybe the following Sunday, they were admitted to Holy Communion for the first time by the parish priest.

Conscious that most of our young people preparing for Holy Communion have more limited experience of Sunday Mass than previous generations, we in Ireland have had programmes like *Do this in memory* where the children and their families are given a special place at one Sunday Mass per month in their parishes.

The priests of our family of parishes have planned to have such a programme in common for all our parishes this year. The programme has been prepared by the same people who wrote the school religion books. The weekly take home page from school is one important element of preparation. Even if children don't take home their religion books, the weekly Home Link page can be photocopied for them to take home. Additionally, there will be material given to families by the parishes for preparing the monthly parish Sunday Masses.

In the next couple of weeks priests and parents/guardians will meet to launch the preparation for First Communion next Eastertide (in practice, during the month of May). The first monthly Masses in October will include the enrolment ceremony. We know that all the parishioners look forward to having those preparing for First Communion be with us on those Sundays.
