PRAYER FOR THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

Concern for our beloved dead is particularly strong among Catholics and more so among Irish Catholics. Our Catholic faith tells us our prayer and penance for those who died in God's good graces is helpful to them as they make their way from the edge of heaven to seeing God's face. While our sins are forgiven through the Lord's offering his life and our cooperation (especially in confession), our sins still need purging either through prayer and penance in this life, or through purgatory on the fringes of heaven. Our purgatory can be sped up through the assistance of those who come after us; our numerous kinds of prayer for the dead are part of assisting them.

In recent decades, gathering in cemeteries for common prayer for the dead has become more frequent and more appreciated, but the way it is arranged, scheduled and considered (getting to 'our' cemetery or cemeteries) puts a lot of strain on some people.

The Church suggests a simpler, personal kind of prayer for the dead. It does not matter which particular cemetery one visits. From the perspective of the faithful departed, they would much prefer us to live the Gospel than just turn up annually for a prayer service in the cemetery where they're buried. The more personal prayer for the dead is probably much more beneficial than our annual attendance.

Plenary Indulgence of 2nd November

From 12 noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November one plenary indulgence (applicable only to the Holy Souls) may be gained by visiting a church or oratory and reciting the *Our Father* and the *Creed* there. Conditions for gaining a plenary indulgence:

- Go to Confession (in the week preceding or the week following 1st November)
- Receive Holy Communion (One Holy Communion for each indulgence)
- Pray for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father, and Hail Mary or any other prayer of one's choice)

One should have the desire to be detached from every attraction to sin, even the slightest.

Plenary Indulgence during 1st to 8th November

The faithful who visit a cemetery (any cemetery) and pray for the dead, may gain a plenary indulgence (applicable only to the Holy Souls) once per day from 1st to 8th November. The already enunciated conditions regarding Confession, Holy Communion and prayer for the Pope's intentions apply also for this.
