PRAYER FOR OUR BELOVED DEAD DURING NOVEMBER

Plenary Indulgence of 2nd November

From 12 noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November one plenary indulgence (applicable only to the Holy Souls) may be gained by visiting a church or oratory and reciting the *Our Father* and the *Creed* there.

Conditions for gaining a plenary indulgence:

- Go to Confession (in the week preceding or the week following 1st November)
- Receive Holy Communion (One Holy Communion for each indulgence)
- Pray for the Pope's intentions (one *Our Father*, and *Hail Mary* or any other prayer of one's choice)

One should have the desire to be detached from every attraction to sin, even the slightest.

Plenary Indulgence during 1st to 8th November

The faithful who visit a cemetery (any cemetery) and pray for the dead, may gain a plenary indulgence (applicable only to the Holy Souls) once per day from 1st to 8th November. The already enunciated conditions regarding Confession, Holy Communion and prayer for the Pope's intentions apply also for this.
