#### POINTS OF VIEW

From the First Sunday of Advent in the diocese of Cork and Ross, we will make three slight changes in our 'Points of View' at Mass.

In order to make our postures more closely aligned with the meaning of the parts of the celebration, and to follow practices in the rest of the country, and indeed with the rest of the Roman Catholic world, we will stand for three additional moments at Mass beginning with the Saturday night and Sunday morning Masses at the start of Advent (29th-30th of this month):

- From the start of Mass until we sit for the readings.
- When the priest says 'Pray, brothers and sisters' until we have finished singing or saying the 'Holy, holy, holy Lord'.
- For the Prayer after Communion until Mass has ended.

Standing is a posture of activity, and recalls our baptismal dignity already sharing in Our Lord's glory in the resurrection. It will be easier for us also to sing the *Lord, have mercy*, the *Glory to God*, and the *Holy, holy*, with unencumbered lungs.

The new arrangements for us in Cork and Ross are also in line with ancient practices, with assisting at what used to be called 'High Mass', and with the liturgical renewal of the Second Vatican Council that encouraged full, active and conscious participation of all Christ's faithful in the sacred liturgy, not just praying interiorly and observing, but joining in the celebration in body and voice too.

Speaking of vocal participation, our family of parishes will make some small changes to our singing the Mass also on the First Sunday of Advent. More on that in next Sunday's newsletter.
