SIXTH CLASS CHARITY CHALLENGE AT RATHBARRY N.S.

Back in 2022, to mark the end of their time at Rathbarry National School, our Sixth-Class pupils decided to celebrate by giving something back to the community. They came up with the idea of fundraising for a charity by completing a series of sporting challenges. What began as a one-off event has since grown into a much-loved tradition. In doing so, they have supported a number of local charities including Lisheen House, West Cork Animal Welfare, West Cork Rapid Response, Courtmacsherry RNLI & Inchydoney Inshore Lifeboat, Cork Cancer Connect and Ardfield/Rathbarry Community First Responders. These charities were chosen by Sixth Class each year, ensuring that monies raised directly benefits causes close to their hearts and community.

By completing different challenges, including duathlons and triathlons, the Sixth-Class pupils have raised an incredible total of almost €3,700. The triathlon involves three events. The pupils begin the challenge by running from our school to the Galley Flash Rowing Club. One lap of the lake is completed in the rowing boat. Following this, the class get on their bikes to cycle the scenic, coastal road towards Owenahincha. The route then goes through the woods to Breda's shop

in Rathbarry village for an ice cream and a chat before heading to school where they are welcomed back by the whole school. The duathlon event is much like the triathlon without any rowing. We are proud of all these thoughtful and caring pupils who have represented our school over these years, and we look forward to this tradition continuing again this year and for many years to come in our school.
