After Holy Communion: **'Let us pray'**, stand till end of Mass

SAINT BRIGID IN 2026

The feast of St Brigid of Kildare falls on a Sunday in 2026. Since she is co-patron of our country and not principal patron, her celebration shouldn't ordinarily trump the celebration of Sunday. However, the bishops' conference have decided to include a commemoration of the saint in Sunday Mass. This will be clear in the missalettes where they are used. The readings will be of the Sunday – fourth Sunday of the year – but the *euchology* (the prayers of the Mass) will be those for the saint. What about hymns? Hymns to the saint are not so commonly

known, the writer has never heard the one in the Veritas hymnal sung, but if one is used at Mass it is best placed at the conclusion of Mass.

THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD IN THE TEMPLE

Also called Candlemas, and falling on 2nd February, the fortieth day after Christmas, is a major feast for the Church. Mass begins on this feast day of the Lord with a candle-lit procession commemorating the Lord's entry into the Temple as 'the light to enlighten the gentiles', to quote Simeon.

CONGREGATIONAL SINGING IN OUR FAMILY OF PARISH

The pastors of our parishes have asked our wonderful choirs to lead us in singing the following:

- *A Thiarna déan trócaire* – we repeat after they have sung it
- Plainchant *Alleluia* – we repeat after we have listened to them singing it through once; they sing the verse of the celebration; we all join together in singing the *Alleluia* the third time. We will have a Lenten alternative from Ash Wednesday, sung in the same listen-repeat, wait, all repeat fashion.
